## Current projects being undertaken by Executive committee:

**CAPES:** At this stage CAPES is a member of the executive council at Nedlac, as well as on various committees at Busa.

At Cosatu's 9<sup>th</sup> National Congress in September 2006 they released the following statement" *We will ensure full protection of casual and subcontracted workers through changes in the labour laws and through creation of decent jobs; and by fighting the conversion of temporary jobs into full time employment*" Capes will be involved in protecting the interests of the temporary employment market for this year.

**Nursing Act:** In corresponding with Ms Subedar, I was informed that it seems as if the agencies will be falling under the Department of Health.
